### Seat distribution for WJ elections

The Wolesi Jirga is composed of a total of 249 elected members.

'Seats distribution' is the method by which it is determined how many seats are allocated to each province plus the Kuchi constituency.

The number of seats that each province receives in the WJ has been determined by the Joint Electoral Management Body (2005), based on the Constitution, the Electoral Law and population figures from the Central Statistics Office.

The 'seats distribution' is as follow:

- ✓ Ten seats are reserved for elected representatives from the Kuchi population.
- ✓ The remaining 239 seats are distributed among provinces.
- ✓ Each province receives at least two seats.
- ✓ At least 68 seats are reserved for elected women representatives.

### IEC Decisions

IEC approved decision n. 114-1397 Elections timeline, presidential election and WJ for Ghazni province. Elections timeline for provincial councils and district councils.

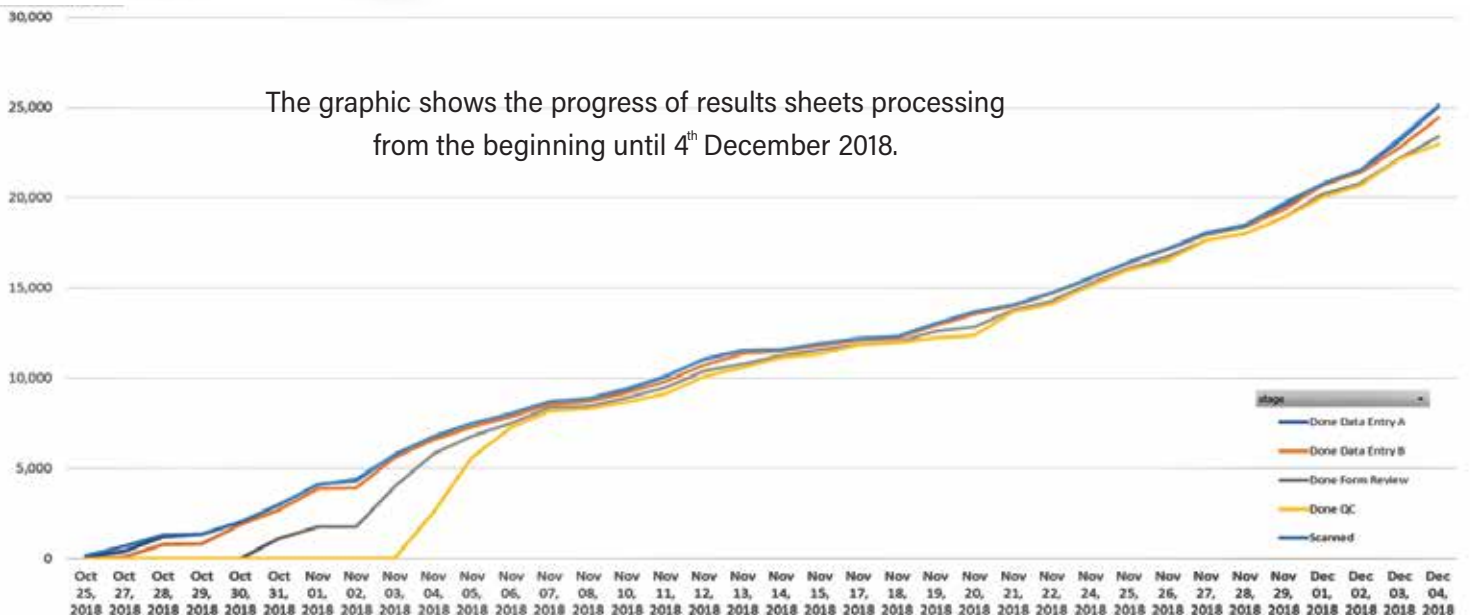
According to the paragraph 2 of article 71 of the election law, IEC decided that:

1. The presidential election and Ghazni parliamentary election are to be held at the same time on 20 April 2019. The approved election timeline should be announced officially.
2. Both the provincial and district council elections are to be held at the same time on 21 September 2019. The approved election timeline should be announced officially.

### Tally process and BVV

Over 4.200 TEB intaken at NTC containing over 15.500 results forms (RF) out of which more than 13.000 have been processed. Among them, more than 4.000 recounts forms from 29 provinces.

Upload of data from BVV is completed. Of 4.812 PC opened for WJ elections, only 4.571 have used BVV. Data from almost 18.000 BVV devices was transferred to the server for a total of more than 3.100.000 biometrics records uploaded.



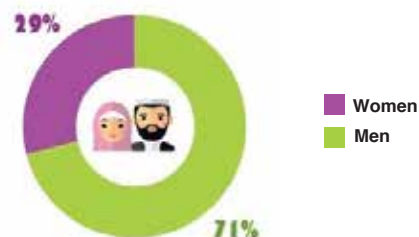
### Recount Status

Recount for Central region has been completed except for Kabul province. For the latter, three warehouses (WH) have been set up at IEC HQ and a total of 226 teams composed by 2 people were hired to speed up the audit and recount process.

### IEC Preliminary Results

The IEC is announcing results from provinces as soon as tally process is completed. At this stage, IEC has published the preliminary results and names of winning candidates of 20 provinces. Complaints and objections to preliminary results may be submitted to ECC within two working days from their publication.
